### easySRI 1st Press Release

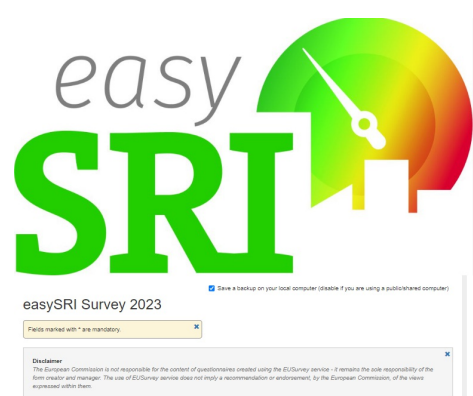
