Halfway There!

easySRI started in November 2022, and now we can proudly announce that it has reached the halfway mark in its journey towards achieving its objectives. The consortium has had a kick-off meeting and two plenary meetings. At the midpoint of its trajectory, easySRI has achieved two important milestones, the first version of the easySRI architecture, and easySRI implementation framework. In addition to that, twelve deliverables of the project have been submitted so far. These deliverables mainly consist of project management deliverables, market analysis and scenarios, and theoretical framework studies and development.

Conferences and Networking

easySRI participated in the 4th NDA Next Gen EPC Cluster workshop, to collaborate and coordinate common actions with its sister projects. CRES participated at the audience as an easySRI partner in the 7th EcoMobility Conference in Feb 2024, the outcomes of which regarding the home charging status, and policies, were reflected in deliverable 6.1 of the project.

Collaboration fuels innovation, and easySRI is no stranger to fostering collaborative endeavors. In alignment with this ethos, the project has forged partnerships with sister projects [Smart²](#), [SRI-ENACT](#), and [SRI2MARKET](#). The consortium will have their 4th plenary meeting soon. They will meet in Madrid in May 2024. In addition to that, easySRI will participate in the next SRI joint event in October 2024. In the coming period, the first version of easySRI web platform will be out as well.
